Congratulations to the Development Bureau on the launch of its 2023 Major Projects Leadership Programme under the Centre of Excellence for Major Project Leaders, a centre with great ambition and goals.

Infrastructure and construction have long been indispensable to Hong Kong's development. We have also long been internationally recognised for our formidable strengths in infrastructure development.

In the pipeline in the coming decade are far-reaching landmark developments, including the Northern Metropolis and the Central Waters Artificial Islands, to create a more liveable and economically vibrant city for the people of Hong Kong.

In the medium to long term, we anticipate our construction volume to reach about HK\$300 billion a year, a massive investment in infrastructure and urban development, which demands prudent management of resources. The Hong Kong SAR Government and Hong Kong people expect nothing less.

Flyvbjerg's research has been covered by Nature, Science, The New York Times, The New Yorker, The Wall Street Journal, The Economist, The Financial Times, China Daily, The BBC, CNN, National Geographic, and many other media.
